

Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch-Up Premium Report 2018/19

Foreland Fields School was allocated £5,500 Year 7 Catch-Up Premium for the 2018/19 academic Year (Based on 11 students). When including last year's rollover, the total Year 7 Catch-Up funding allocated for the 2018/19 year was £11,228.00.

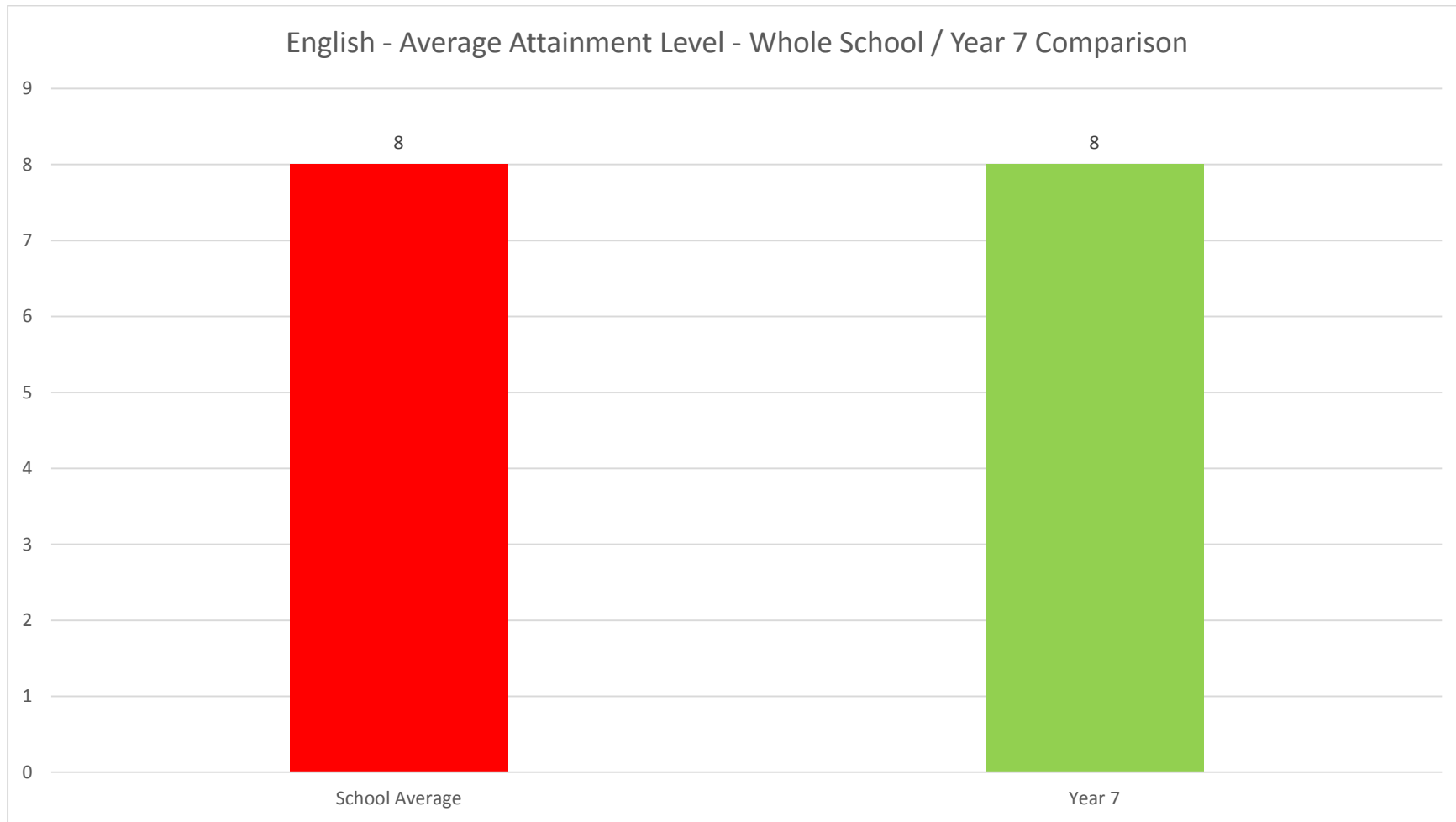
This funding was allocated to improve outcomes for our Year 7 learners in the following ways:

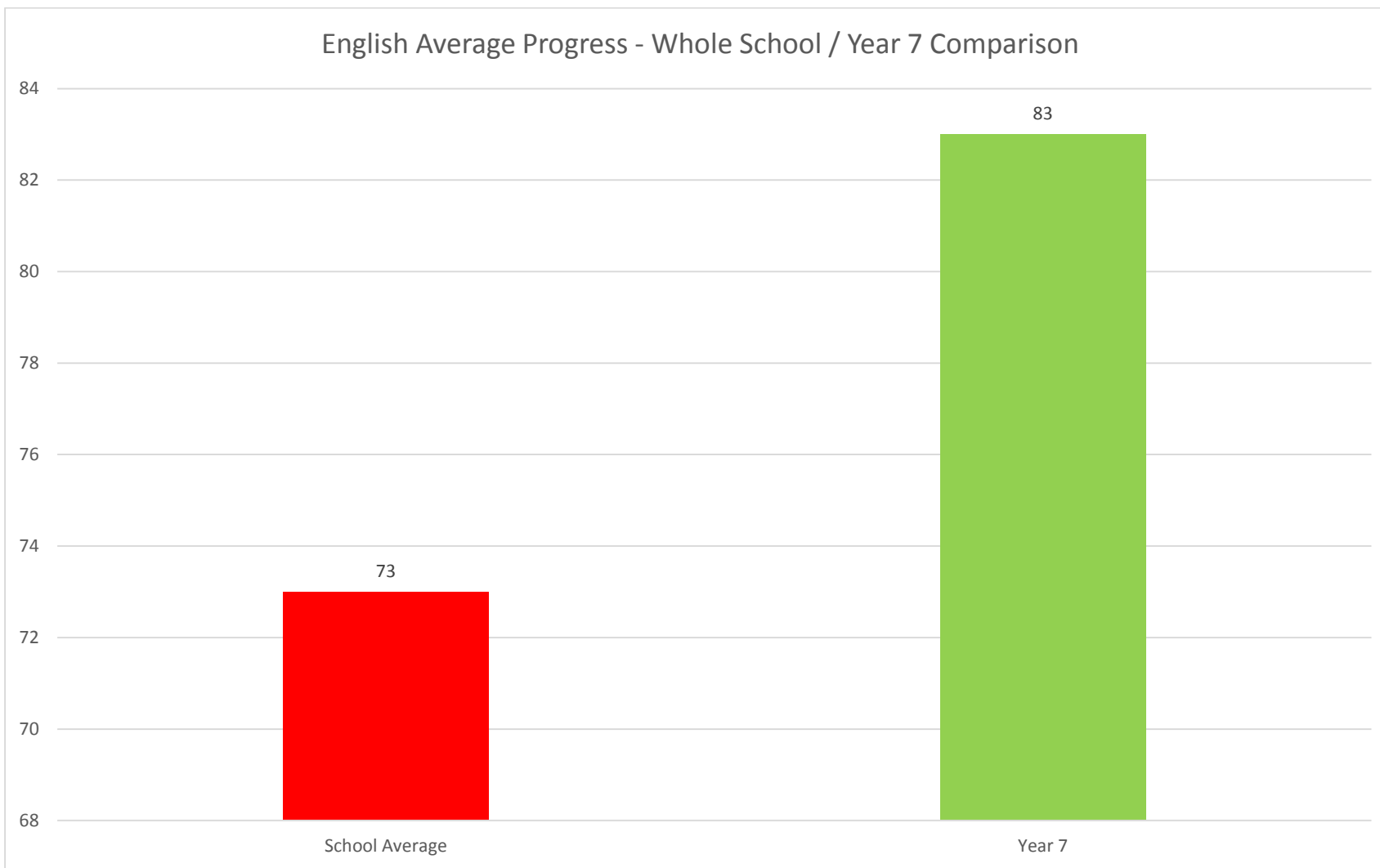

English Average Progress - Whole School / Year 7 Comparison

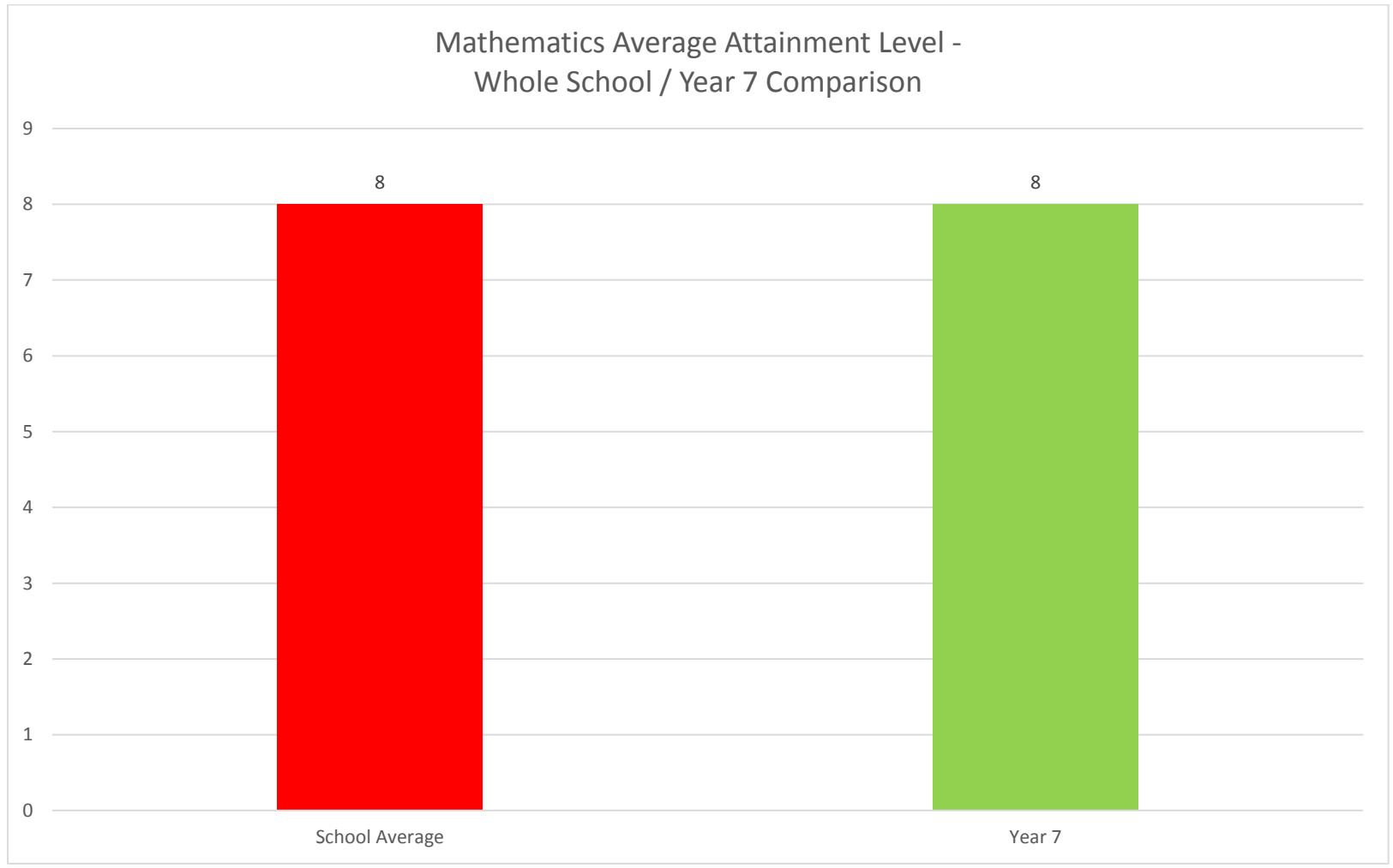

Mathematics

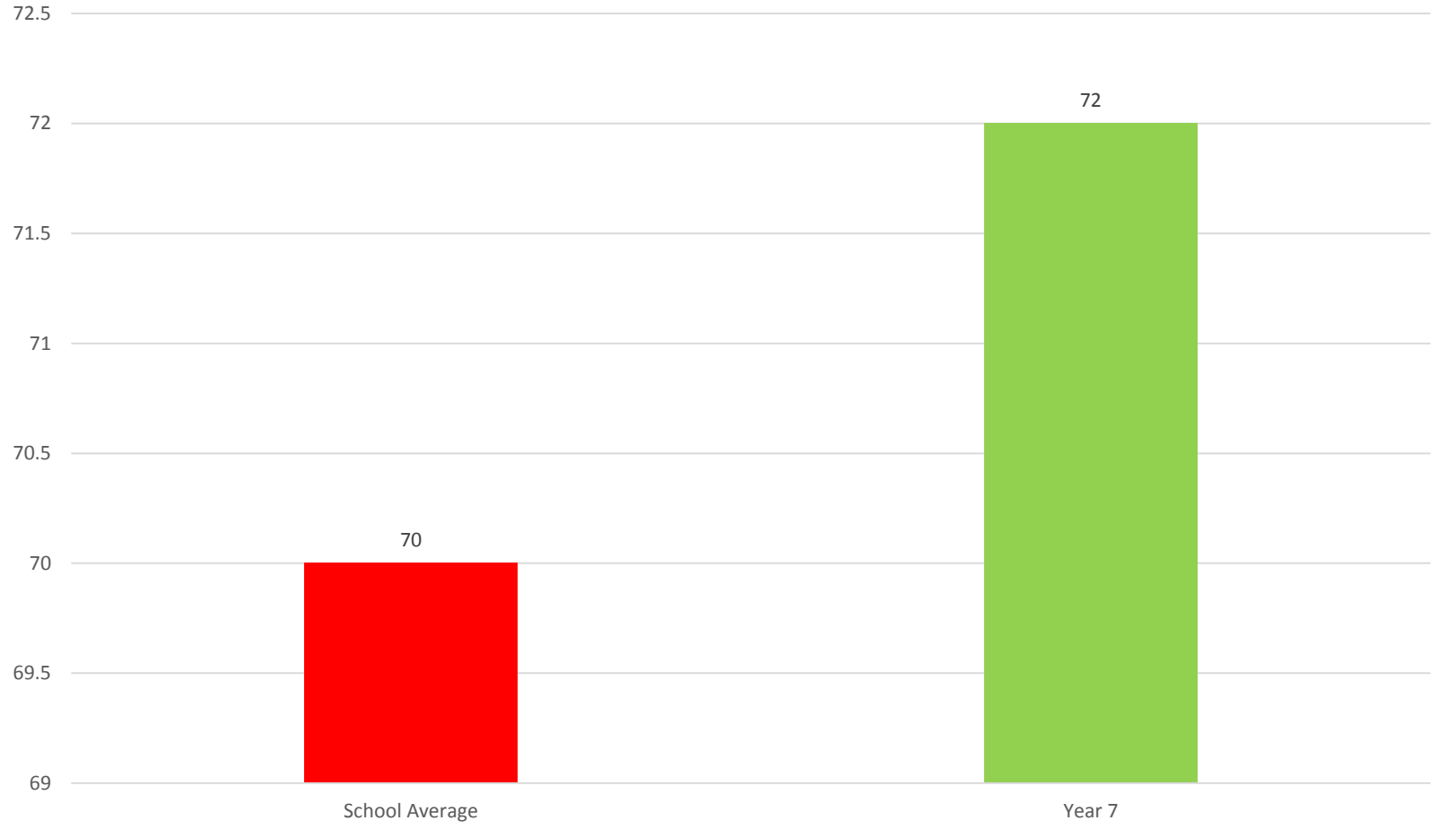
Attainment

2019/20 Year 7 Catch Up Funding Allocation

Foreland Fields School has been allocated £8,500 Year 7 Catch-Up Premium for the 2019/20 academic Year (Based on 17 students). In addition, £4,197.50 remained unspent from the 2018/19 allocation therefore the total Year 7 Catch-Up funding available for the 2019/20 year is £12,697.50.

We intend to spend the money in the following way:

- Upper Pay Scale Teacher to continue to work with individuals and small groups to raise attainment in literacy and numeracy – one morning each week.
- Additional resources to be purchased to support the raising of attainment in literacy and numeracy. Specific online programmes to support literacy development.
- Training for support staff in literacy and numeracy support in order for them to support Year 7 students across the week.
- Mental Health and Wellbeing training for secondary staff to support transition for students.
