Dear Parents/Carers

We are now a couple of weeks into the new term and other than a few changes to classes, pupils/students appear to have settled into the routines of school. We have visited our satellite classes and again all pupils/students seem happy within their new surroundings.

As you will all be aware, school and all of our satellite provisions will be closed on Monday 19th September due to the State Funeral of Her Majesty the Queen. We will open on Tuesday 20th as normal.

Communication

Moving forward we are reducing the amount of letters sent out to parents in order to cut down on waste. Termly Newsletters will be sent electronically through ClassDojo and the website. If any parent/carer would prefer to receive communications in hard copy, please let us know.

ClassDojo is the most effective and convenient way for us to share news about your child and the school. Could I please ask that if there are any parents/carers who have not yet signed up to join ClassDojo, but wish to do so, they contact their child's class teacher who will send home a parents' agreement for completion prior to sending on a unique password to join the app.

COVID/Sickness

The latest guidance regarding COVID is largely unchanged. The guidance states that children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and where possible avoid contact with other people. They can come back to school when they no longer have a high temperature and they are well enough. It is not recommended that children and young people are tested for COVID-19 unless directed to by a health professional however, if a child or young person has a positive COVID-19 test result they should try to stay at home and where possible avoid contact with other people for 3 days after the day they took the test.

Many of our pupils and students are vulnerable to infections which can spread quickly at this time of year. Remember, your child should be kept away from school for 48 hours from the last period of sickness or diarrhoea. Details from Public Health England about infectious
