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| <b>Pupils Accessing Swimming</b>                               |   |
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| 46 KS2 pupils accessed swimming<br>September 2019 - March 2020 | <p>Only 1 of these pupils accessed regular swimming opportunities outside school. All pupils made progress with physical development, dressing skills, communication and interaction skills and confidence.</p> <p>1 pupil who has sensory processing needs has difficulty tolerating water/washing. She made regular progress during the block of lessons and from being unable to enter the pool at all initially, progressed to being able to do this independently by the end of the block.</p> |
